Despite the restrictions that have affected so many of us, it is wonderful to be reminded by the Apostle Paul that God's word cannot be chained or restricted! We can also be thankful for His faithfulness, and for how He has given the Church new ways to reach children with the Gospel.

In April we began recording short video lessons and sent them to the Sunday School families to watch at home. This required more involvement from the parents and we are glad that they too heard the Gospel this way. For the past five months however, we have held Sunday School online through 'Zoom'. This facilitates better interaction with a small, but reasonably consistent, number of children joining in each week for Bible stories, songs, games and quizzes. We felt led to take the children through a complete book of the Bible, and are now halfway through Mark's gospel!

Although our summer Holiday Bible Club had to be cancelled, we were invited to volunteer with Bible Centred Ministries (BCM) for a week of socially distanced events in Carryduff. The week turned out to be an especially wet one, but it meant that a daily children's Bible Club ended up being held in the sports hall at Carryduff Gospel Hall! This was a fantastic opportunity to work with an enthusiastic team of volunteers, many of whom were from different churches in Carryduff. A family BBQ during the week also provided a great opportunity to develop relationships with some of the residents in the Killynure area of Carryduff.



God also used this week to build new friendships with other Christians in the area, and we're looking forward to receiving help from some of them for our Christmas outreach. Please pray for us as we plan an evening or two of outdoor home visits with some carol singing, gifts and Gospel literature.
