I WILL PRAISE THEE WITH MY WHOLE HEART.

There is something a little bit mysterious about the job and role of the conductor of an orchestra. To the untrained eye they stand on a podium and wildly flail about their arms in front of a group of musicians who already have an intimate knowledge of the music scores they are performing. They are the only member of the orchestra who has no instrument and makes no sound throughout the full performance. It surly causes us to ask the question: what is their contribution to filling the auditorium with a euphony of sound?

At a basic level conducting is very simple. It keeps an orchestra in time and together. But that's just the starting point. Most importantly a conductor serves as a messenger for the composer. It is their responsibility to understand the music and convey it through gesture so that the musicians in the orchestra understand it perfectly. Those musicians can then in turn transmit a unified vision of the music out to the audience. It is the purpose of this prayer letter for us to try and show forth "all thy [God's] marvellous works", throughout Armagh, in various ministries this past summer to give you cause for praise.

JUNIOR CAMP: This is the beginning of summer ministry as it begins only days after children finish school. Armagh Baptist church kindly hosted our 35 children and 17 leaders for the week. There was kite flying, Lego workshops and clay modelling but it was the teaching that impacted lives. Throughout the week many questions were asked and answers given right up until the parents came to take their children home; with a young girl coming to faith on the Thursday evening after getting her questions answered.

INTERS CAMP: The final note of the summer came from the teens residential, ran by Andrew and Claire McNabb. 57 teenagers filled the faith mission centre, Portadown as they settled in for the week. Listening to teaching on "Encounters with Jesus" and "Connections" sparked many impromptu discussions. The clarity of the answers enabled a teen girl to call upon the name of the Lord after returning home on Friday afternoon.

5 DAY CLUB MINISTRY: 5 Day Clubs begin as soon as early May, with faithful groups of volunteers who year upon year brush off their tarpaulins, order a few bits of literature and knock on doors to round up groups of children to teach them the Bible in the open air. You might expect any number of children to attend, from 3 to 55. With the involvement of Christian Youth in Action, led by Neil and Amy Verner we recorded 54 5 Day Clubs in total reaching roughly 1,500 children.
